- Supporting the established relationships with families; and the 'culture' of the centre.
- Participating and contributing to the pedagogical discussions and studies.
- Being an intentional practitioner and communicator.

- Proven self-motivated team leader
- Proven high level interpersonal, written and oral communication skills
